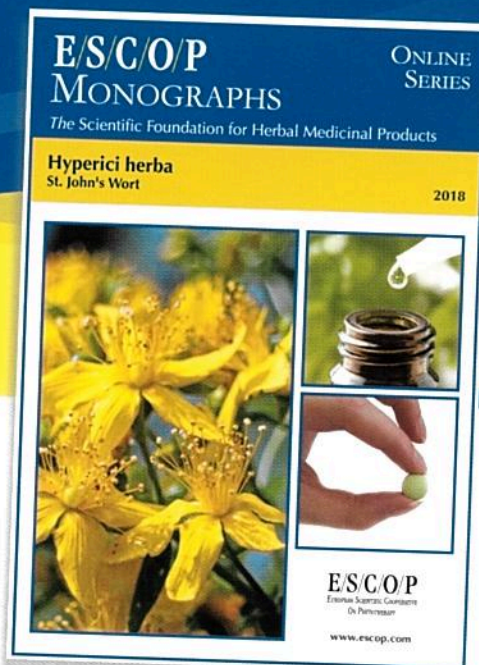

The European Scientific Cooperative on Phytotherapy, has published a new updated version of its monograph St. John's wort (Hyperici herba) with the therapeutic indications "mild depressive disorders and mild to moderate depressive episodes", which is available for immediate download from ESCOP's website

The monograph represents the current state of knowledge on efficacy and safety of this widely used herbal drug and its preparations.

ESCOP was founded as an umbrella organisation in 1989 representing national phytotherapy or plant-based medicine associations across a wider Europe, with the scope to advance the scientific status of herbal medicinal products, to promote the acceptance of herbal drugs and to assist the harmonisation of their regulatory status at a European level. ESCOP has actively contributing members and delegates from 15 European countries and associations. Each ESCOP monograph is the joint work of many experts from these countries, all giving their time voluntarily to the production of this harmonised assessment of efficacy and safety. Since 2011, 48 individual herbal monographs, including updated revisions, have been published online.
